

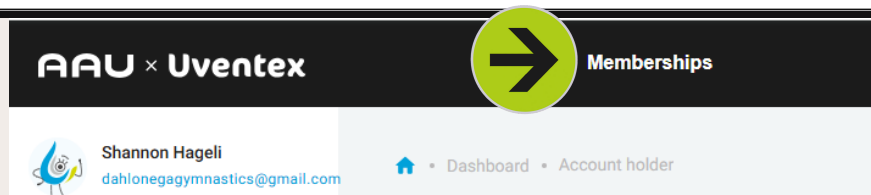
GA AAU TeamGAGymnastics.com Membership Process



Create Uventex account and register the main club contact.

1

AAU is using a new system for all sports. Your information from last year is not yet available. Go to aausports.org and create a new account with Uventex. From the membership tab select the non-athlete membership, fill out the form for yourself and pay for the membership. ***The regular membership is sufficient for gymnastics.



Background Check for Adults required.

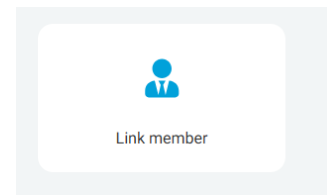
NCIS background checks are required for everyone 18 and over. When you apply for membership you will get an email about the background check. Open this email and complete the additional information. When you pass the check you will receive another email with your member number. You can now complete the process for your club and minor athletes.

Link your membership first to your Uventex account.

Click on the link shown to add your member number to your Uventex account. Your member number will be available only after you have passed the NCIS background check.

Go back to the membership tab and select the Club Membership and repeat the process to register your club.



Club complete? Now register your athletes.

Once your club membership is complete you will have a club ID. Use this number to make sure gymnasts are registered under your club. Regular membership is sufficient for gymnastics. Junior Coaches (age 18 and under) need an athlete number to be on the floor. They may never be left unsupervised while coaching.

Register for your license/sanction first. Please send the sanction number to Denise at gaaugym@gmail.com. Your meet will be added to the website. You can then advertise your meet on the Facebook Ga AAU page. There is no longer a cap on entry fees for a one judge panel. You can charge anything you like. Your club will need a Level 2 membership to host meets.

All athletes must compete in a MINIMUM of 2 in-state meet prior to the deadline to qualify to the GA AAU State Championship- No Exceptions!

Music update: NGB rule has been revoked. You can use any music as long as there are no human words. Sounds are fine....no words in any language

Apparel update: There is no deduction for sports bras showing during competition. Athletes may wear shorts or leggings in any color.

Compulsory Routines: Follow all NGB changes to the compulsory routines

Cast amplitude on BARS:

The .1 amplitude deduction for casts that are BELOW the requirement for the level **DOES NOT APPLY** at any level in AAU. * Reminder that GOLD in AAU can perform cast backhip-cast backhip and fulfill the special requirement for bars.

New Skills on Bars!

#8.008 Silver (A) from LB sole circle backward (tuck, pike or straddle, circle around the bar 270* (3/4), with release to stand (dismount)

#8.009 Gold and Platinum only (A) from the HB sole circle backward (tuck, pike or straddle, circle around the bar 270* (3/4), with release to stand (dismount)

#8.010 Gold, Platinum, Diamond, Sapphire (A) From HB cast stoop through and swing forward back kip-up to rear support (thigh on bar), salto backward tucked.

Any athlete that has competed at a level, either inside or outside, of the AAU organization should not compete at a lower level at an AAU competition without petitioning the National Executive Committee.

ALL ATHLETES MUST BE ACCOMPANIED BY A COACH AT ALL AAU EVENTS. IT IS NOT THE RESPONSIBILITY OF THE MEET DIRECTOR, HOST GYM OR EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE TO PROVIDE A COACH FOR AN ATHLETE.
